

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

My trips to the coffee shop are pretty much very infrequent now. People complain about the steam that comes up in the grinder compartment. Although I have to agree that it would be nice if they had worked this problem out, it is no big deal. Just was the pieces. not rocket science. I always was a coffee pot after using it anyway so, again no problem. I was pretty worried about this because of all the complaints. All it means though is that when you put the beans in and then are done grinding and go down into the next compartment, there is a little residual coffee film left from the beans and then steam enters. Big deal. just rinse it out. When I use my stand alone grinder for coffee, I always washed it after I was done grinding anyway. The noise from the grinder could wake you up, but I set mine to go off ten minutes before I wake up for really fresh coffee. The carafe is smaller than the coffee pot. I previously had the Cuisinart model DTC975BKN, which still works but it doesnt grind on its own, and Ive become lazy about doing that. For us, we were always

throwing coffee out with the other model, for just two people. but with the grind and brew there is just enough for 2 travel mugs and two cups of coffee. If you are looking for a bigger pot, do not get this stainless carafe model then. My sons have the glass carafe grind and brew model and I believe it holds more coffee. All in all, for the lazy factor of wanting fresh brewed coffee and not having to grind the beans yourself, we are really satisfied with this product. You won't be unhappy. Just remember to wash out the bean holder, the top to the grinder basket and then you're all set.



I don't believe we go through coffee beans any faster than we did when we ground our own beans, and the coffee always tastes just perfect to us. We fill the bean compartment all the way to the top. So, my review and opinion is: No extra beans used than normal. Thoroughly clean after each use. Lacking Completely Reviewed in the United States on June 16, 2010. Okay I used to have a Melitta Mill and Brew and unfortunately they stopped making them. I would have bought a third mill and brew if they still were around. Aside from a problem with the plastic cap breaking after about three years it worked perfectly and made excellent coffee. A search through the available grind and brew models today offers very little. The Cuisinart is a very disappointing product if you know what can be produced for half the price. Not all of us have counter space to allow this model to have a clear shot from above and you need it to look over the top to see how much water to pour in for your pot of coffee. They could have built in a viewable reservoir from the front to make it easier. After every brew you have to clean the grinding chamber two parts, the brewing chamber three parts and the carafe two parts. The carafe is designed to keep the coffee hot but the cost is that the flow from the carafe is painfully slow. It's over-engineered and ergonomically unfriendly. Even the grinder has no control over the fineness of the grind. It grinds for 10 seconds no matter what you put in it. It's no wonder the coffee sucks. The best thing they can do is redesign the thing completely using the simplicity that Melitta employed years before. Hey Cuisinart! are you listening? The coffee isn't so good considering that it's made from freshly ground coffee beans. This product is not good enough. Let me know when you get it right. I'm returning this one today. However, it is very flimsy, particularly the top flap which must be opened and closed each time you make coffee. Additionally, it overflows in the back if you fill it to the 10 cup line making a mess of your kitchen counter. I also gave up using the grinding option because the moisture builds up inside the grinder and clogs so frequently that it just wasnt worth it. In summary, this is not a coffee pot that I would recommend.unless of course, it was to the neighbor I didnt like much.Please try again later. Please try again later. NorthernVA 4.0 out of 5 stars The Grind and Brew does demand more effort to clean than regular filter coffee makers because three is an additional part to clean, the grind element. This takes approximately 2 additional minutes. The process begins by the grinder spinning a metal cutting wheel which is located within the grind element which is sealed byh a lid that snaps on the top. The compression fitting and good tolerance of the grinding element part makes it stay together with no latch or other contraption that could snap off.

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Upon completion of the grind cycle there is no feedback mechanism that I can deduce, so the stopspinning point is only reached by a static timeout, the majority of the coffee is ground and has slid down the grind element slide through the opening in the top of the basket. It also has a 4cup mode for smaller amounts of coffee which simply cuts short the duration of the grind process. I brew

23 carafes per day, always using grindmode and have become quite efficient at cleaning the grind elements. It is best to use a small amount of dish cleaning soap as this removes the oil from the ground beans which has been pressed against the inner walls and screen of the element. Please try again later. The automatic grind is wonderful, as Ive always had trouble with grinding coffee. Since this machine does it itself, I dont need to worry that Im grinding the coffee beans too coarsely or too finely. The machine does it perfectly. The timer is also great. Its been a dream of mine to be able to wake up to coffee for a very long time. My boyfriend doesnt like coffee though, and doesnt know how to make coffee. So, theres no chance of him surprising me with coffee in the morning. With the programmable brew available, I can now set my coffee up measure and prepare beans and water in the evening, and have my fresh coffee in the morning. The thermal carafe is one of my favorite aspects of this machine. I generally only drink one cup of coffee at a time, although I like to have coffee on demand. With other coffee makers, I would make a pot of coffee, then need to reheat the coffee in the microwave. With the thermal carafe, my coffee stays piping hot pretty much all day. The water filter is also a nice touch. Good water makes good coffee, so its a definite bonus to have the water filtered. The only issue is, replacement filters can be very expensive, but that really isnt much of an issue for a coffee maker this great. And, it looks great on my counter top too. Please try again later. The cons A major design flaw is the fact that the steam from the hot water gets everywhere into the machine, including the grinder making it a pain to clean and requiring cleaning between most brews. With so many movable parts that have to be rinsed and the grinder that has to be dried prior to use, its not a simple process. It is loud when in grinds coffee. My boyfriend and I call it the spaceship. The grinder makes a ridiculous amount of noise compared to its size. This could be an extra plus if the sound of the grinder serves as an extra alarm in the morning to wake up. I fear that it annoys my roommates, however. Other people complain about The slow speed with which the coffee comes out of the carafe. I dont mind taking a few extra seconds to pour a cup of coffee it means that its piping hot but

I thought Id deal with the tough clean up and just enjoy such a great looking piece of machinery. Well, theres no doubt about it. Cuisinart has truly goofed with this machine that simply doesnt do what its buyers bought it for. Make good coffee. First of all, the directions seem to have been written by someone who was in a rush. Theyre vague, at best. I made myself slow down, reread, focus. Still a blur. Still, thats not a reason to return a coffee maker. The grinder wakes the dead. That doesnt bother me, Well, I didnt think it would, but the truth of the matter is, as loud as you think its gonna be, its WORSE but not a reason for me to return the coffee maker. I should get up earlier anyway. Cleaning this is like a logic problem from the LSAT exam.

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Just as all of the reviews said, but I guess I didnt believe it would be so bad, because afterall, it IS Cuisinart. It is that bad. Grinds get in every possible crevice that has to be removed, piece after piece after piece. Im too much of a slob to look after so many pieces and clean them all with QTip precision. As much as I tried to get some of the wet, stuck to every corner gunk out, Including with a toothpick after all else failed it wouldnt budge. Still, I wouldnt return the coffee maker for this. Now heres why Im returning it Really bad coffee. Here you have it The coffee isnt hot. I dont like scalding hot coffee, I hate it as a matter of fact. No bones about it, the coffee was luke warm. Which would defeat the self timer feature.the box doesnt mention that, does it. Id preset it the night before. Lukewarm coffee, now thats a reason to return this piece of junk. Lastly and most importantly to me Weak coffee. I had read that complaint several times on the board, so I had prepared I put in seven scoops for 5 cups. So how would it have made the ten cups its supposed to. So, in lieu of getting anymore upset about this defective product, Im sending it back tomorrow. The frequency depends upon the hardness of your tap water and how often you use the coffeemaker. I believe the latch sticks and doesnt close the lid tightly enough. It will appear to be closed, but the latch isnt all the way in place. So, there is a small screw on the inside of the latch in the lid. Carefully unscrew this, remove the screw, latch, and the small spring. Remember which way the latch faces. With a warm damp paper towel, clean the latch and the slot in the lid that the latch goes into. Reassemble, and make sure the screw is not so tight that the latch doesnt move freely. This should solve your problem.Happy hunting Carnac the Magnificent All of us having this problem cant be wrong and it must be defectiveMine does the same thing.For customer service call 8007260190 and they will walk you through the return process.I have purposely disassembled my 500 to clean out the tracks and basket latch and have successfully reassembled. In fact, right now Im waiting for the coffee to finish to enjoy a fresh cup although, all be told, at this point Id rather go grab a beer!; The trick with replacing the spring is that it has two different ends one with a hook that is horizontal to the coil of the spring; the other hook

perpendicular to the coil. The horizontal hook goes around the back peg of the latch lever, with this leg being against the bottom side of the lever. The other hook is used to maintain the tension and is placed against the side body of the sliding shelf.

When placing the spring into place the angle of separation between the two legs is approximately 15 degrees note the legs do NOT overlap ie, go past each other they maintain their respective sides. The trick that I learned was to continue to apply downward force on the latch lever, thus forcing the retention peg to be as fully exposed as possible. This reduces the very frustrating occurrence of the spring slipping off the peg when you try to reinstall the cover. If that does not work you might have to purchase a new lid.
